## Memorial Scholarship

The core mission of the Darleen Patterson Loggins Memorial Scholarship is to promote educational opportunities through scholarships, with emphasis on Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM).



The Loggins Family seeks to complement South Bay Community Church's commitment to students that excel in STEM subjects and plan to pursue an education and career in a STEM or healthcare field.

The scholarship is a one-time award for high school graduates attending a four-year college, two-year college, or vocational school.

**NOTE:** Scholarship recipients will be required to show documented proof of school registration before funds can be awarded.

### How to Apply

- Complete your application. All items noted on the Scholarship Application must be included.
- Visit the SBCC website at [sobcc.org/scholarships](http://sobcc.org/scholarships) to complete the online application and submit with all required documents to [Dloggins.scholarship@gmail.com](mailto:Dloggins.scholarship@gmail.com) no later than **Friday May 8, 2026**.

**Note: Incomplete applications will not be accepted.**

### Who is Eligible?

- Students who attend South Bay Community Church and have a high school grade point average of 2.5 or higher (3.0 in STEM courses), and meet all requirements described in the scholarship application
- Students completing their senior year of high school
- Students who have been accepted by an accredited post secondary institution and will begin their education or training in the first academic year following their graduation from high school

### What Types of Schools Qualify?

- Any two-year or four-year undergraduate college, university, or vocational institution

### How are Scholarship Recipients Chosen?

- The Loggins family will make the selection for the scholarship.
- The selection for the scholarship will be based on the following criteria:
  - Application and requirements completed and submitted by the due date
  - Demonstrated excellence in STEM course work
  - Demonstrated academic promise and growth
  - Strong involvement in STEM or healthcare-related activities through volunteer work or work experience
- Applicants must be available for finalist interviews if required.

### Important Dates

■ May 8, 2026	Completed scholarship application due. Also due is an official college acceptance document.
■ May 18, 2026	Scholarship finalists notified of interview appointments, if required.
■ May 22-29, 2026	Scholarship finalists interviewed, if required.
■ June 8, 2026	Scholarship recipients notified
■ June 14, 2026	Recipients recognized during the SBCC Baccalaureate Service
■ September 30, 2026	Proof of college or vocational school registration due to the SBCC Scholarship Committee

**IMPORTANT: Scholarship funds cannot be disbursed until proof of registration is received.**
